# • Buildings and Grounds (Liam/Nancy)

Phase 1 study & tracing of all wiring and line diagram with recommendations about what to replace/leave alone will cost \$2000 or less; Phase 2, or actual construction, estimated at \$8000.
- Parish Cleanup workday scheduled for Saturday, April 13 from 9:00-12:00; B&G is identifying things to fix like entryway to parish hall and plumbing in men's restroom
- Brick for vestibule to be replaced by Gary

## Peace Meal Report (Liam; Hannah Harkey)

- Peace Meal received fewer funds from diocese; Hannah Harkey is connecting with the diocese for more information and to get copy of grant application
- Hannah and Scott Splater are reaching out to other congregations for Peace Meal fundraising and will next attend Church of St. Michael's and St. George for Easter egg hunt.
- Hannah has coordinated de-escalation training w/ Mark Brennan for Peace Meal volunteers
- Peace Meal will experiment with a return to coordinating indoor dining; Hannah, Scott, or Nancy will verify any news.
